

**HOUSTON MARATHON FOUNDATION TEACHER GRANTS
PRESENTED BY CHEVRON
OFFICIAL RULES**

1. **NO PURCHASE NECESSARY:** Void where prohibited. Subject to applicable federal, state and local laws.
2. **ELIGIBILITY:** Contest is open only to legal residents of the United States who are 18 years of age or older and are either a teacher, educator, coach, after-school teacher, club director or program director in the education field. Employees of the Houston Marathon Foundation ("HMF"), the Houston Marathon Committee ("HMC"), Chevron North America Exploration and Production Company ("Chevron"), and each of their respective subsidiaries, affiliates and advertising/promotional agencies, and the immediate families and household members of each, are not eligible.
3. **HOW TO ENTER:** To enter the contest, entrants must complete the registration form on ChevronHoustonMarathon.com. Only one entry per person.
4. **ENTRY PERIOD:** The entry period will begin when the Contest is launched on various HMC media platforms and end on January 3, 2022 at 11:59 pm CT.
5. **SELECTING THE WINNERS:** On or about January 7, 2022, a HMF and Chevron employee will select fifty (50) winners out of all eligible entries received. The HMF will contact the winners via email and/or phone number provided upon contest entry.
6. **GENERAL CONDITIONS:** The Sponsor of the Contest is the Houston Marathon Foundation, 720 N. Post Oak Rd. Suite 200, Houston, Texas 77024. The decisions of the HMF are final in all matters. By entering the Contest, you agree to be bound by these Official Rules. By entering the Contest, you agree to the use of your name, photograph, voice, likeness and demographic information in any manner and for any purpose in any media now known or hereafter developed, without additional compensation or your prior review, unless prohibited by law. Upon the HMF's request, each potential winner will be required to sign and return an affidavit of eligibility and publicity/liability release upon being notified that he or she is a potential winner. If the document is required and a potential winner does not sign and return the document, such potential winner will be disqualified from the Contest. By entering the Contest, you agree that the HMF may enter your name and contact information in their database and that the HMF or their designees (e.g., HMC sponsors) have your permission to contact you with a list of other ways, from which you may choose, to be involved with the HMF and HMC. 8. **RELEASE:** By entering the Contest, entrants agree to release the HMF, the HMC and Chevron, and each of their respective affiliates, and the directors, employees and agents, including without limitation, advertising and promotion agencies, of each, from any liability, loss or damage incurred in connection with or arising out of the Contest, or from his or her use, misuse or acceptance of a prize.

If the HMF determines (in its sole and absolute discretion) that, for any reason, the Contest is not capable of running as planned, or the integrity and/or feasibility of the Contest is undermined by any event beyond the control of the HMF, including but not limited to fire, flood, epidemic, pandemic, contagion, earthquake, explosion, labor dispute or strike, act of God or public enemy, satellite or equipment failure, riot or civil disturbance, war (declared or undeclared), terrorist threat or activity, or any federal, state or local government law, order, or regulation, order of any court or jurisdiction, infection by computer virus, unauthorized intervention, technical failures or other cause not reasonably within the control of the HMF (each a "Force Majeure" event or occurrence), the HMF reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to abbreviate, cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Contest and/or proceed with the Contest, including the selection of winners in a manner it deems fair and reasonable, such as the selection of winners from among eligible entries received prior to such cancellation, termination, modification or suspension without any further obligation. If the HMF, in its discretion, elects to alter this Contest as a result of a Force Majeure event, a notice will be posted on the HMF website or where the Contest Rules are posted.

9. **PRIZE RESTRICTIONS:** No Prize substitution or exchange will be allowed, except by the HMF, who reserves the right (but not the obligation) to substitute a prize of equal or greater value in case of unavailability of a Prize or force majeure.
